


CONGRESSMAN TOM PRICE, M.D.



Representative Tom Price, a third generation physician, first found his calling for service as an orthopaedic surgeon treating patients in the metro Atlanta area for over twenty years -- during which time he became an advocate on behalf of a stronger and more responsive health care system. Price felt that positive solutions were needed to ensure that health care policies enacted by our government would not adversely impact the ability of patients and families to find access to quality, affordable health care.

In 1996, Dr. Price formally entered elective politics prevailing in both primary and general elections to represent Georgia's 56th State Senate District. As a member of the State Senate, Price proved himself to be a tireless worker. Elected Minority Whip twice, State Senator Price helped lead the Republican Party to a majority in the State Senate -- ending 150 years of majority Democratic rule. This led to Price being chosen by his colleagues to serve as the first Republican Senate Majority Leader in Georgia history.

In 2004, Dr. Price was elected as the representative for Georgia's Sixth Congressional District. As a Member of Congress, Representative Price has earned a reputation as a leader in health care policy and an advocate for a more limited, effective, and efficient government. In previous congresses, Price has served as Chairman of the Republican Study Committee -- the caucus of House conservatives -- and as Chairman of the Republican Policy Committee. Currently, Representative Price serves as the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, in addition to his assignment on the House Ways and Means Committee.

Born and raised in Michigan, Representative Price earned both his Bachelor's degree and Doctor of Medicine from the University of Michigan. Price moved to Atlanta for his residency in Orthopaedic Surgery at Emory University. Following this training, Representative Price opened an orthopaedic practice in Roswell. Prior to running for office, Representative Price also served as an Assistant Professor of Orthopaedics at Emory University while being the Medical Director of the orthopaedic clinic at Grady Memorial Hospital in downtown Atlanta.

Dr. Price currently resides in Roswell, Georgia and is married to Dr. Elizabeth "Betty" Price, a member of the Roswell City Council. They have one adult son and attend Johnson Ferry Baptist Church in Marietta, Georgia.
