Tim Seay MD, FACEP, a Bachelors and Masters graduate of Texas A&M University (1983 and 1984), received his Doctor of Medicine from The University of Texas Health Science Center in San Antonio (1989) and completed an emergency medicine residency at Cook County Hospital in Chicago (1994). He is board certified by the American Board of Emergency Medicine (ABEM) and a Fellow of the American College of Emergency Physicians (ACEP). Tim has 20+ years experience private practice clinical emergency medicine. In 1998, Dr. Seay was one of the founders of Greater Houston Emergency Physicians (GHEP) which currently staffs 12 hospitals and free-standing clinics throughout Texas. GHEP employs about 70 physicians.

Tim is intensely interested in emergency department efficiency and flow and has led his physicians to trial numerous and varying intake models. He is also interested in physician entrepreneurship and his team has designed, built and operated a number of free standing emergency clinics on behalf of GHEP investment arm, The Tifaro Group, LP.
